Introduction

Set amongst 400 acres of rolling ranch land in the hills above Nicola Lake, Sagebrush is a massive golf course in every sense of the word; plenty of length from the tips, wide fairways, huge greens, and big elevation changes. Sagebrush was designed as a links-style golf course; fast and firm playing conditions evoke the ground game, adding extra dimensions to one's shot options, and allowing golfers of all skill levels to play running shots should they choose to do so.

Sagebrush's traditional scorecard uses the term Standard Scratch Score (SSS), rather than Par.

There are no rattlesnakes in the Nicola Valley, but the areas outside of Sagebrush's fairways do have insects and animals, such as marmots and mice.

Teeing Grounds

Sagebrush has four sets of Tee Decks for our golfer's enjoyment. However, there are no markers on any of the tee decks; Sagebrush tradition suggests that the player who has earned the honour dictates the exact tee position which is to be played.

Course Markings

Your golf cart's GPS will provide maps, yardages, directional assistance, and other information to assist in playing your round. Aiming rocks assist with blind tee shots, while white markers on the edge of the fairways indicate 150 yards to the middle of the greens.

Bunkers

The bunkers at Sagebrush are played as waste areas; you are permitted to ground your club while addressing the ball. There are no rakes located within the bunkers, however, golf carts are equipped with rakes to allow you to restore natural lies once you have played your shot.

The Hideout

Located alongside the 13th hole; Sagebrush's guests can enjoy lunch and other refreshments pond-side, and/or relax with a little fly fishing at The Hideout. Swimming is **not** permitted at The Hideout Pond.

"Pace of Play" & Course Routing

Daily capacity at Sagebrush is limited to less than sixty players, with groups' start times spread out by at least twenty-minute intervals. This allows Sagebrush's guests to have more freedom in experiencing the golf course. Guests are permitted to 'set their own pace,' provided that each group's experience does not infringe on any others'. We require all guests to respect each others' position on the golf course; some guests may choose to take a leisurely pace, to hit extra shots or take photos, while others may choose to play quickly and get more holes in. To our guests whom wish to play at a slower pace, or spend some time at The Hideout during your game, please allow other groups to play though when practical to do so.

Respect of Others

Sagebrush is an inclusive facility, welcoming everyone to enjoy all the resort has to offer. We require all guests to respect each others' position on the property. These expectations are non-negotiable; guests found to be in violation of this will be asked to leave.
