Sagebrush is an all-inclusive golf club, welcoming everyone to enjoy everything the game and our club offers. Upholding the game's traditional values and etiquette is very important to us. Our expectation is that all guests respect everyone's right to enjoy the game equally. We also expect our guests to be courteous and respectful to our staff at all times. The USGA and R&A Rules of Golf Govern all play.

Sagebrush offers our guests a very unique and intimate golf experience. A limited daily field of golfers helps to ensure this objective. We expect all guests to respect each other's pace of play. Guests playing at a slower pace, or who choose to spend time at the "Hideout" during their game, please allow for faster groups to play through when it is safe and practical to do so.

Sagebrush has four sets of Tee Decks for our golfer's enjoyment. However, there are no Tee markers on the Tee Decks. Sagebrush tradition dictates that the player who has earned the "Honour" determines the Tee position to be played, and she/he may also determine the order of play.

Sagebrush bunkers are played as waste areas. Rakes are not located within the bunkers (waste areas); however, all golf carts are equipped with rakes to allow golfers to restore natural lies.

Sagebrush Golf Carts are equipped with GPS Graphic Screens with Hole descriptions and yardages. Sprinkler heads are not marked. White markers at fairway edges indicate 150 yards to center of green.

Sagebrush refers to Standard Scratch Score (SSS) instead of Par on the scorecard.
